He was born and raised in Cleveland where he graduated from Collinwood High School in 1997. At the early age of eight, young Chef Eric worked in his grandparents' restaurant cooking family recipes that he uses today in some of his soulful dishes.

In the last ten years, Chef Eric has opened several restaurants in Cleveland and Columbus, won countless awards, made numerous television appearances, and managed to be a contestant on the Food Network's Guy's Grocery Games. He currently is one of the owners of Black Box Fix restaurant in Legacy Village. Chef Eric is very dedicated and works around the clock until everything is up to his extremely high standards, demonstrating his passion for excellent food.

Chef Eric's grandparents always taught him to give back to the community. He is dedicated to realizing these lessons, highlighted by his service to Cleveland's senior community during the COVID pandemic. He worked with The Western Reserve Agency on Aging (WRAA) to provide 1000 meals a day to seniors in need. When Meals on Wheels needed a new food provider, we were drawn to Chef Eric because of the good things we heard about his work with WRAA.

Once Chef's meals are prepared, our volunteers create individual portions for our clients. Chef Eric's hot meals include a protein such as chicken or beef, a starch such as pasta or potatoes, and a vegetable. His cold meals consist of a sandwich, fruit, and a cookie or chips. Our clients also receive a green salad with each meal. The feedback from our clients has been both positive and appreciative. We are grateful to Chef Eric for his service to Meals on Wheels.
